APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

- Application Fees

- Competency Profile Assessment
- Memberships and Affiliations of Originating Jurisdiction
- Post Graduate Institution Syllabus – translated to English as appropriate
- Post Graduate Diploma
- Resume of Related Work Experience
- Employer Letter of Reference
- Related Continuing Education Programming
- Provide the results of a criminal record check
- Sign a declaration stating whether the applicant is currently under investigation for unprofessional conduct or has been disciplined in the past by the College or by another regulatory body. This is on the second page of the application form.

After Application is received at the College of Dental Technologists of Alberta

- Successful completion of a Prior Learning Assessment Recognition (PLAR) to be administered by the CDTA. The PLAR is a four-part technical assessment consisting of: cast partials, dentures, crowns, bridges and orthodontics should the applicant seek licensure as an RDT. An applicant has the option of completing one or more of the above mentioned competencies to be granted a license as a DT.
- Successful completion of a Comprehensive Theory examination.
