



Infection Control for the Dental Technologist

Course Details:

This course will provide students with the prerequisite knowledge required to practice effective infection control procedures in the dental environment (clinic & lab) and to prevent cross-contamination. This course also provides a scientific background of microbiology in relation to infection control practice. This information will give students knowledge regarding infection control used in the dental office and overview of selected disinfectants and sterilization protocol. This module will introduce the student to the proper handling of hazardous chemicals, employee safety, and waste management. Upon completion, the student will gain insight into workplace hazards and safety guidelines within the dental environment. Throughout the course, learning activities are provided to integrate theoretical information and clinical practice.
